About the Hatchery Maintenance Technician Position

The hatchery maintenance technician's responsibilities will vary with their skills and abilities. Specific problems you may work on include:

- Maintaining & installing electrical/mechanical components in a land-based aquaculture facility.
- Performing corrective and preventative maintenance on process and facility equipment.
- Inspecting, repairing, rebuilding or replacing various pumps, gear reducers & drives, motors, shaft seals, bearings, and mechanical seals.
- Installing of process & utility equipment (electrical/mechanical /instrumentation/plumbing).
- Becoming sufficiently familiar with the operation of all plant equipment in order to identify irregularities and provide quick and innovative solutions to equipment and process issues.
- Maintaining a preventative maintenance program for facility equipment and keeping detailed records of maintenance including equipment manuals, repair histories and spare parts inventories.
- Following all in-house safety protocols and adhering to all Standard Operating Procedures, including existing Biosecurity Regimes.
- Working independently and in conjunction with management and supervisors to maintain communication expectations.
- Expected to be part of the alarm response call-out list.

Essential Qualifications

- Diploma from a Mechanical or Electrical trade program or engineering tech program.
- Industrial Millwright Red Seal with maintenance experience in an industrial or regulated production facility, or other trade with similar experience.
- Willing and able to work overtime, weekends, holidays, on-call when necessary.
